Addams ES showed an increase from 17% in 2015-2016 to 39% in 2016-17 in third grade ELA: Met + Exceeded (SBAC) scores



9% DECREASE



CHRONIC ABSENCE RATES

All In Pilot schools showed an average 9% decrease in their chronic absence rates from 11.65% in 2015-2016 to 10.65% in 2016-17



MAJOR SUBGROUP DECREASES

UP TO 66% DECREASE



African American, 25%; Hispanic, 17%; Foster Youth, 66%; Homeless, 0.7% and Low SES, 11%
